Two lucky Commercial Bank Credit Card holders have won cash to the equivalent of a holiday in Singapore by opting for electronic statements instead of the printed monthly statements. Additionally, the Bank presented 2,000 Max Loyalty Rewards points each to the first 1,000 Credit Card holders that converted to e-statements during the campaign period.

The Max Loyalty Rewards Points allocated as rewards can be redeemed by cardholders at the rate of one rupee per point, making a total of two million rupees

in prize value.
