Etihad Airways, resumed flights to Sri Lanka operating four A320 flights per week between Abu Dhabi and Colombo. Colombo is Etihad's first new route launched in 2010. They have also expanded their code share relationship with Sri Lankan Airlines by adding several key destinations beyond Abu Dhabi.

Taking up the role of country manager will be Kumar de Silva who has reestablished the airline's office in Colombo and will oversee its operations in Sri Lanka.
