Jayantha De Silva, Vice President South Asia of IFS – a leading global ERP solutions provider explains how important they can prove to be in maintaining proper management and thus competitiveness of a company in the modern business arena.

An enterprise is entirely constructed on its resources, physical or otherwise, and the optimal use of these results in how effectively company objectives are achieved. "If you have a company with about ten people you know exactly what they do, because you get involved. When you grow bigger, direct involvement is humanly impossible, and then you need a good solution to push and pull information to properly manage the business. This is where ERPs come in," De Silva explains.
