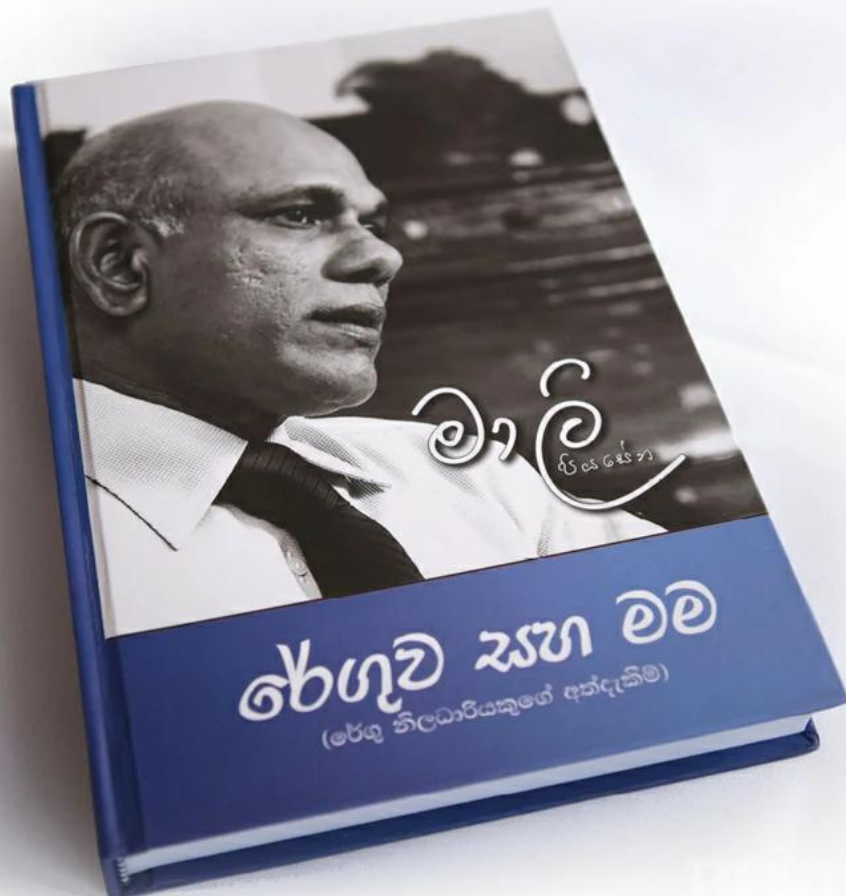


Launch Of Reguwa Saha Mama - A Book That Details The Life Of A Customs Officer
