opportunity for the local participants as they're given the chance to participate in a globally recognised competition at a minimal cost and do not have to spend on travelling to another country."

She also goes on to say, "We are granting access for everyone for almost no-cost. Even the knowledge that the observers would gain in these two days of activities is invaluable."
