There is also free access to the Trans Asia's famed pool area, which is just a short walk from the gym and changing facilities. With the backdrop of Beira Lake, the pool is the largest to be found at any of Colombo's luxury hotels, and provides the perfect atmosphere of tranquility for either individuals or families to spend the weekend, soaking up the sun, or relaxing in the cool water. The pool area is also noted for it's excellent food, which includes regular themed buffet lunches. Members also receive discounts at some of the hotel's shops and highly regarded restaurants.
