Designed to be bigger, drive better, and packed with more technological innovation than before, the new MINI continues to be the leading original of the premium small car segment. The petrol engines include turbocharging, direct fuel injection and variable camshaft control on the intake and exhaust side (double VANOS).

This MINI Countryman is the first four-door MINI with a body measuring of more than four meters in length and comes with a large tailgate and a versatile interior offering space for up to five people. It can even be ordered with all-wheel drive.
