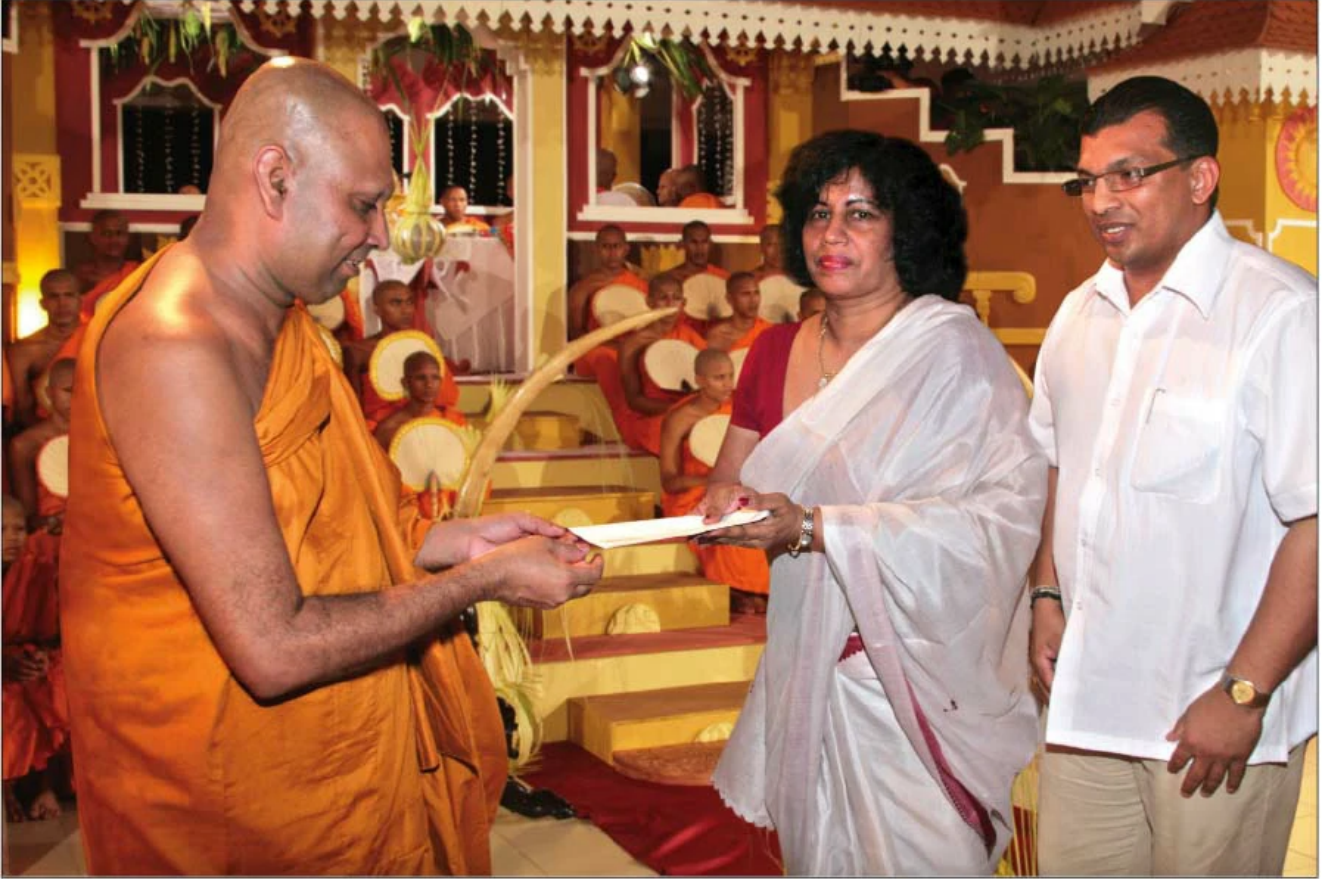


The Buddhist Channel Via PEO TV
