

The Prime Minister and Cabinet Officially Sworn In

The cabinet of the National People's Power (NPP) government was sworn in before President Anura Kumara Dissanayake at the Presidential Secretariat. The cabinet comprises 21 ministers, with President Dissanayake assuming responsibility for the portfolios of Defence, Finance, Planning, and Digital Economy.
